Ordinance Section 4-201A, requires all dogs and cats in Noble's city limits to be licensed through Noble Animal Control. License can be purchased from the Noble Police Department (inloudes a metal tag to be worn by your pet at all times). This allows an officer to immediately locate the animal's home and return him or her promptly. A current rabies tag issued by a licensed veterinarian should be worn as well
