# **NOBLE ANIMAL CONTROL**

The best thing you can do for your dog or cat is to place collars and tags on them.

City of Noble Ordinance Section 4-201A, requires all dogs and cats in Noble's city limits to be licensed through Noble Animal Control. License can be purchased from the Noble Police Department (includes a metal tag to be worn by your pet at all times).

This allows an officer to immediately locate the animal's home and return him or her promptly. A current rabies tag issued by a licensed veterinarian should be worn as well.

**City of Noble Ordinance Section 4-102** It is unlawful for any domestic animal to be at large at any time within the City.

City of Noble Ordinance Section 4-111D Allows two (2) dogs per residence.




