

CITY OF NOBLE ORDINANCE NO. 584

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOBLE, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING THE NOBLE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 9, PART 12, SECTION 901, PARAGRAPH QQ, DEFINITION CLASSIFICATION NUMBER 8 BY AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF GROUND SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY IF BY SEPARATE VOTE THE CITY COUNCIL DETERMINES THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS NECESSITATING THAT THIS ORDINANCE BE DECLARED TO BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS ADOPTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOBLE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That Definition Classification No. 8 of Paragraph QQ of 12-901 of Chapter 9, Signage, of Part 12, Zoning Regulations, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Noble, is hereby amended, which shall hereinafter read as follows:

**8. "Ground signs" means a sign which is supported by one or more columns, uprights, poles or braces extended from the ground or from an object on the ground or a sign which is erected on the ground; providing, that no part of the sign is attached to any part of any building structure or other sign.**

**a. A free standing pole sign for all industrial and commercial businesses shall not exceed 4 feet by 8 feet (32 square feet) unless the lot size shall exceed 2 acres. Two sided signs are permitted. For industrial and commercial businesses on 2 or more acres requesting free standing pole signs with more than 32 square feet, the maximum pole sign are shall be approved by the city manager or his designate.**

**b. On all commercial and office zoned businesses, one free standing ground sign is permitted no larger than 4 feet by 8 feet (32 square feet). A two-sided sign is allowed. For business locations where there are two occupants (each having a separate business), ground signs must be located on the same pole or structure and each sign area shall not exceed 3 feet by 6 feet (18 square feet). For three or more businesses in the same location, or in a strip center, pole sign areas shall be located on the same pole or structure and restricted to a maximum of 2.5 feet by 5 feet (12.5 square feet).**

SECTION 2. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. Provisions Severable.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase or any part thereof is for any reason determined to be unconstitutional or adjudged invalid or ineffective by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such determination or adjudication shall not affect or impair the validity or effectiveness of the remaining parts, provisions or portions hereof.

**EMERGENCY CLAUSE**

**WHEREAS**, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, welfare and safety of the City of Noble, Oklahoma, and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage as provided by law.
