

ORDINANCE NO. 619

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF CITY OF NOBLE, OKLAHOMA NOBLE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE DISTRICT GENERAL OBLIGATION LIMITED TAX BONDS, SERIES 2025 IN THE SUM OF \$510,000 BY THE CITY OF NOBLE, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZED AT AN ELECTION DULY CALLED AND HELD FOR SUCH PURPOSE; PRESCRIBING FORM OF BONDS; PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION THEREOF; DESIGNATING THE REGISTRAR FOR THE ISSUE; PROVIDING FOR LEVY OF AN ANNUAL TAX FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS AND FIXING OTHER DETAILS OF THE ISSUE; APPROVING THE FORMS OF A CONTINUING DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT AND AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT; ESTABLISHING THE CITY'S REASONABLE EXPECTATION WITH RESPECT TO ISSUANCE OF TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATIONS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025 AND DESIGNATING THE BONDS AS QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATIONS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTIONS AND ACTIONS NECESSARY FOR THE ISSUANCE AND DELIVERY OF THE BONDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of January, 2025, pursuant to notice duly given, an election was held in the City of Noble, Oklahoma (the "City"), for the purpose of submitting to the registered qualified electors of such City as Proposition No. 1, the question of the issuance of the bonds of said municipality in the amount of \$510,000 pursuant to Article 10, Section 9C of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to provide funds for the purpose of acquiring one or more emergency medical vehicles (ambulances) and equipment related thereto (referred to herein as the "EMS District Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, as shown by the Official Certificate of Votes by the County Election Board of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, at said election there were cast on Proposition No. 1 by the registered, qualified electors of said City 132 votes, of which 110 were in favor of and 22 were against the issuance of said EMS District Bonds; and

WHEREAS, a lawful majority of the registered qualified voters voting on Proposition No. 1 cast their ballots in favor of the issuance of said EMS District Bonds, and the issuance thereof has been duly authorized; and

WHEREAS, there is currently authorized, yet unissued, \$510,000 of EMS District Bonds; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the governing body of said municipality at this time to issue the amount of \$510,000 of EMS District Bonds, and to offer said bonds for sale as a single issue, pursuant to Title 62, Oklahoma Statutes 2021, Sections 353 and 354, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOBLE, OKLAHOMA:

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF EMS DISTRICT BONDS

PURSUANT TO THE LEGAL NOTICE AS IS REQUIRED BY THE OKLAHOMA OPEN MEETING ACT INCLUDING THE POSTING OF NOTICE AND AGENDA AS IS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS THEREOF, THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOBLE, OKLAHOMA (THE "CITY") MET IN SPECIAL SESSION AT THE NOBLE CITY HALL/MUNICIPAL BUILDING, LOCATED AT 304 S. MAIN STREET IN SAID CITY ON THE 7TH DAY OF APRIL, 2025, AT 6:30 O'CLOCK P.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Phillip Freeman, Vice-Mayor Forrest Michell, Bernard Rabbitt, and Chad Terrill

ABSENT: George Schmerer

Notice of a special meeting of the governing body of the City of Noble, Oklahoma having been given in writing to the City Clerk of said City at 3:30 o'clock p.m. on the 3rd day of April, 2025, and public notice of this meeting, setting forth the date, time, place and agenda was posted at 3:30 o'clock p.m. on the 3rd day of April, 2025, by posting on the City's Internet website (www.cityofnoble.org) and by posting at the entry to the Noble City Hall/Municipal Building, 304 S. Main Street, Noble, Oklahoma, 73068 in prominent view and open to the public twenty-four (24) hours each day, seven (7) days each week, being twenty-four (24) hours or more prior to this meeting, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and State designated legal holidays, all in compliance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act (as attached hereto). Further, as required by Title 25 Oklahoma Statutes § 311A(9)(a)(1), the City made the notice of a public meeting available to the public in the principal office of the public body (304 S.
